If there are any discrepancies or overlap in applications, a lottery system will be used to determine placement.

Eligible students who do not receive a spot due to a classroom being full will be notified and placed on a waitlist. The family will be contacted is a space opens up in the classroom.

Upon turning in this form, the \$25 application fee and **ALL** required documents, our admissions office will reach out to you to schedule any needed meetings or let you know the status of the application within two weeks. If your child is accepted at Fellowship Christian Academy, the non-refundable \$75 acceptance fee is required to officially secure his/her spot at FCA. The acceptance fee must be paid within two weeks.
